Scarecrow Festival

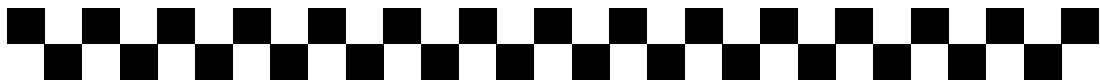
